D. Chinese currency is called renminbi. It is also called kuai or yuan.

Just like in the USA, popular currency denominations include 100, 50, 20, 10, 5, and 1.

In China, four is considered unlucky and best avoided. The Chinese word for four is si 四, which is similar to the word for dead, si 死, but pronounced differently.

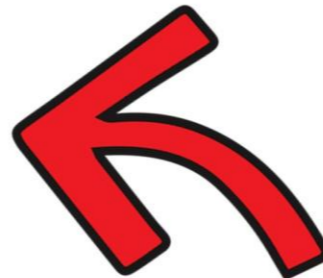
