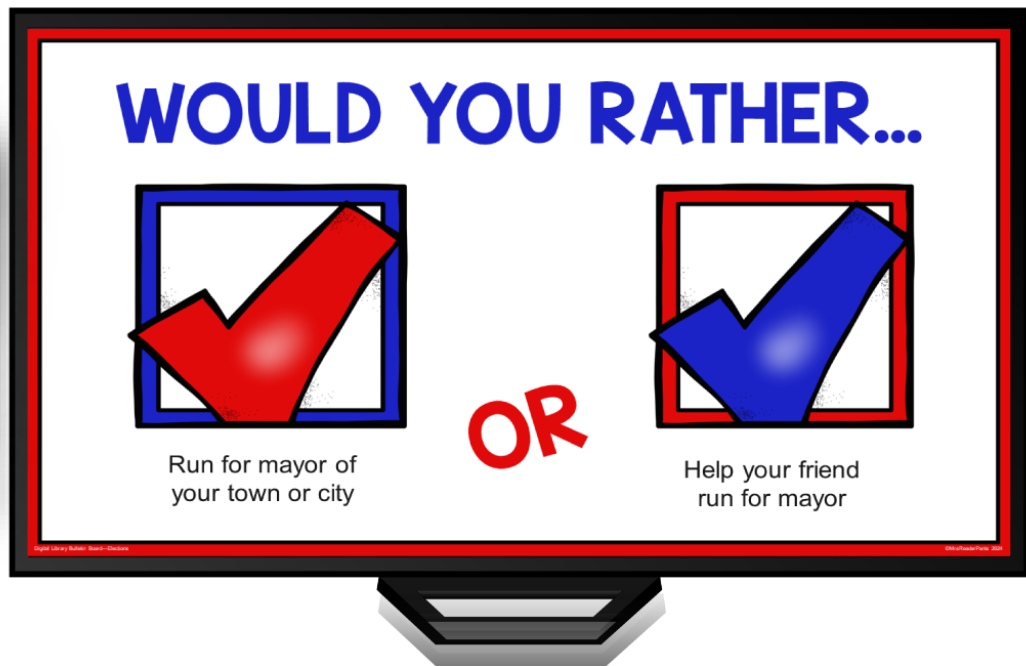
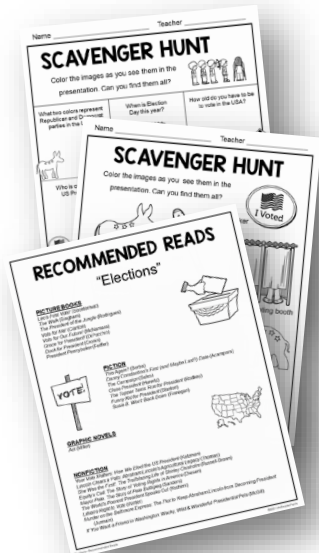

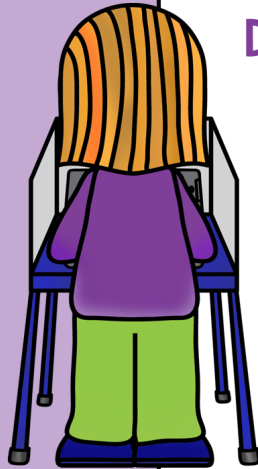

To date, the USA has never had a female president.

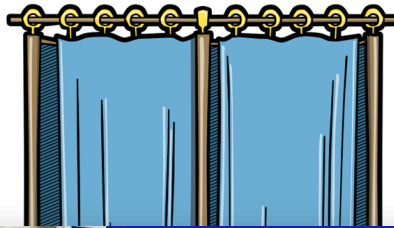

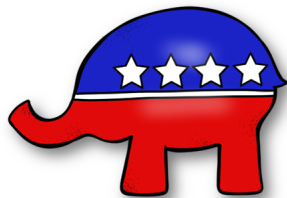
POLITICAL PARTY

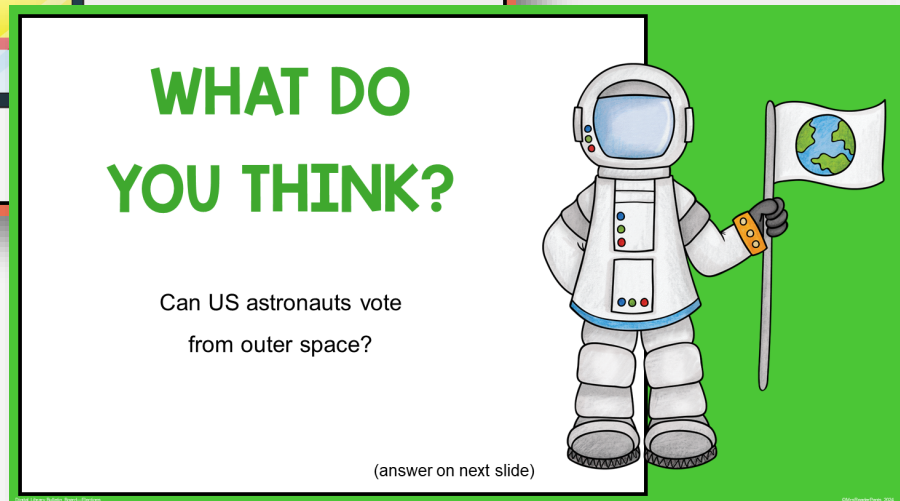

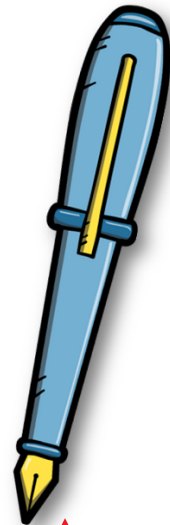
